ALOHA STATE GAMES ENTRY FEE – The entry fee of \$35 per person is designed to cover costs of conducting the meet, including awards and insurance.

T-SHIRTS – All persons registering before the **June 15 deadline** will receive a T-shirt. Every effort will be made to supply T-shirts in the size noted on the entry forms; if this size is NOT available, then the next available size will be substituted. **Participants registering after June 15 WILL NOT** receive a T-shirt unless they pay the late penalty (\$10 per person). Commissioner: Glennon T. Gingo
Format: DYNAMIC APNEA (underwater swimming for distance): freediver swims in horizontal position underwater; goal – greatest distance underwater on single breath of air. STATIC APNEA (breath holding) – longest possible breath hold without moving (static), freediver maintains position face down on the surface of the water, or submerged in shallow water; goal – greatest amount of time holding breath while on single breath of air. All activities supervised by Aquatic Safety Specialists in accordance with rules and safety protocols of U.S.A.A. See www.usfreediving.org.

Categories: Dynamic Apnea;
Static Apnea
Divisions: Male and Female by age brackets, 16-19; 20-24; 25-29; 30-34; 35-39; 40-44; 45-49; 50-54; 55-59; 60-64; 65-69; 70+

Requirements: Participants must have mask, snorkel, fins, bathing suit & wet suit (optional); monofins permitted; 27.3-meter pool; water temp approximately 80 degrees.
